Wool4School is an annual student design competition encouraging budding fashion designers to use Merino wool for innovative thinking and creative design. First launched in Australia in 2012, Wool4School now involves over 100,000 students worldwide.

This year, students are asked to create a unique design from 70% Merino wool, taking inspiration from the enchanting world of botanicals. From fashion design to architecture, isual arts, and beyond - there are no limits to your area of design. Investigate and develop your use of colour, texture and decorative techniques as well as the charateristics of wool fabrics and wool innovations.


BOTANICALS

IMMERSE YOURSELF IN THE ENCHANTING WORLD OF BOTANICALS AND LET YOUR CREATIVITY BLOOM IN UNIQUE AND IMAGINATIVE WAYS.

Explore the lush diversity of plant life and draw on nature's artistry to create plant- inspired wool designs. Think of prints, embroidery, and decorative crafts and techniques that reflect the intricate beauty of nature. Use colour palettes from nature's own paint box to bring your designs to life.

Whether you're inspired by fashion, accessories, or interior design, your creation should consist of 1 to 4 pieces and must be made up of at least 70% wool. Unleash your creative spark and demonstrate how the unique qualities of wool have been incorporated, while exploring shape, scale, colour, texture and textile techniques for a design that taps into the beauty of nature.

Create a design that celebrates Merino wool and our planet and let your creativity run free!





HOW? TO PARTICIPATE

EACH STUDENT WHO WISHES TO SUBMIT AN ENTRY MUST REGISTER FOR THE COMPETITION.TEACHERS ARE NO LONGER ABLE TO SUBMIT ON BEHALF OF STUDENTS.



REGISTRATION



To enter Wool4School, fill out the registration form. Once you have registered, you will be sent an email with a confirmation link. Click the link in the email to confirm your registration. Students must register individually to receive important information about the competition. If you participated in last year's competition, you don't need to register again. Simply log in and update your details.



LEARNING RESOURCES



Go to your dashboard to review Wool4School information. You should complete the Wool Appreciation Course for a better understanding of introductory wool knowledge.



DELIVERABLES



Find out what is required for your age group to complete an entry.



SUBMIT YOUR ENTRY



Submit your design through the dashboard. Note, teachers are no longer able to submit on behalf of their students. When received, an expert panel of judges will evaluate your entry against the competition criteria to determine the winners.




